FIRST TAKE seeks talented teens from the New York City metro area with a strong interest in writing and multimedia. This program has produced some of the region's best young professionals and we are looking for future stars.

Students accepted into this program will learn to write and report news, shoot and edit video, plus produce a TV newscast. Students will visit a working newsroom in Manhattan and learn from guest speakers who work in the industry.
